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Introduction

Abbreviations are used in many divisions and departments within the trust. If utilised correctly, they can assist in rapid communication about patients and treatment plans. However, some abbreviations may have multiple or ambiguous meanings with different specialities using the same abbreviations for different pathologies or treatments, or the clinician reviewing patient notes may not be familiar with abbreviations used by different specialities.

This document aims to set out a list of approved abbreviations and act as a guideline for clinicians, staff and patients to allow ease of interpretation of notes and allow for streamlined continuity of care within note documentation.

Included within the document is an outline of abbreviations, which should not be used due to ambiguity or potential confusion of meaning. Accurate transfer of information and record keeping will protect the data integrity of patient notes between primary and secondary care services.

This document will be reviewed and updated on a regular basis as additional abbreviations are identified and approved.
